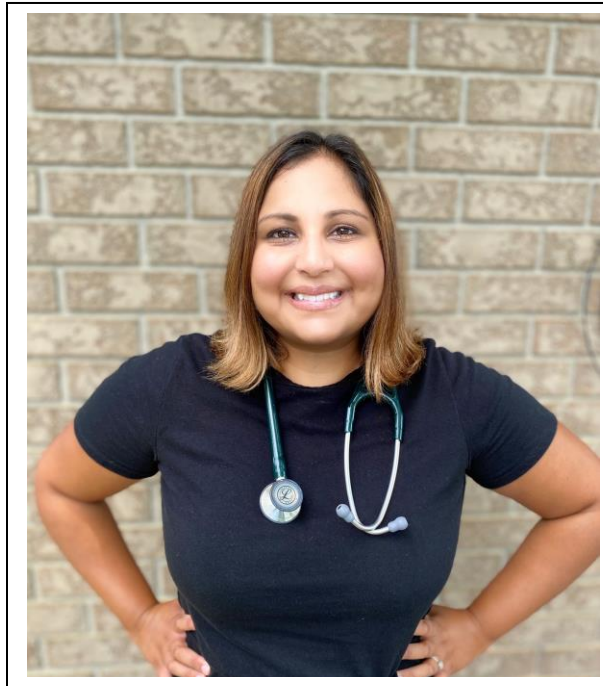
**CHATHAM-KENT: August 27, 2020** – The Chatham-Kent Family Health Team is pleased to announce the addition of two new family physicians.
